

# CASINO CANBERRA



## \$220 Poker Classic tournament

The following conditions are to be read in conjunction with the Casino Canberra Ltd Rules of Poker (Hold-em).

**Game:** POKER – HOLD-EM

**Starting time:** 3pm

**Date:** Saturday, 17<sup>th</sup> March 2018

**Entry fee:** \$220 (\$20 for tournament commission, \$200 for tournament prize pool)

Each player entering the tournament will receive \$10,000 in tournament chips.

**Re-buys:** A player is allowed one (1) re-buy into the tournament according to clause 6 in the general terms and conditions below.

A player who wishes to re-buy into the tournament will be required to pay the full entry fee of \$220.

A player who re-buys into the tournament will receive \$10,000 in tournament chips.

**No of Players:** Minimum 10 - maximum of 40 plus Alternate players for the first 4 levels.

If the minimum number of players have not registered (and/or presented themselves to the Tournament Director/Assistant) by 15.00hrs, then the starting time for the tournament may be delayed by the Tournament Director/Assistant up until 16:00hrs.

The Tournament Director/ Assistant shall announce the revised starting time on or before 15.00hrs. If any player (other than a player who has won, or has been transferred, a seat in the tournament) wishes to obtain a refund of their entry fee, due to the delay, this shall be allowed. If the minimum number of players has not been reached by the times notified as the revised starting time, the tournament shall not proceed.

Late entries, after the tournament has commenced, will be accepted subject to clause 4 of the general terms and conditions below.

### Prize Breakdown:

The prize pool for the tournament shall be distributed in accordance with the following table:

<b>Table Limits:</b>	No Limit
<b>Blinds:</b>	There shall be two blinds increasing as per schedule below. Each level will be played for thirty minutes. At the beginning of the 5 <sup>th</sup> blind level antes will be introduced, increasing with the schedule below.
0-30(mins)	\$25/\$50
30-60	\$50/\$100
60-90	\$75/\$150
90-120	\$100/\$200
120-150	\$100/\$200/\$25
150-180	\$150/\$300/\$25
180-210	\$200/\$400/\$50
210-240	\$300/\$600/\$50

270-300	\$500/\$1000/\$100
300-330	\$700/\$1400/\$100
330-360	\$1000/\$2000/\$200
360-390	\$1500/\$3000/\$300
390-420	\$2000/\$4000/\$400

**Then doubling every 30 minutes thereafter with the big blind always double the small blind. No Ante on heads up play.**

### **General terms and Conditions**

1. The tournament is open to Infinity members (**members**) only.
2. A member claiming a seat in the tournament, as a consequence of a transfer from a player who has won a seat into the tournament (via another tournament conducted by the Casino), must provide satisfactory evidence of the transfer to the Tournament Director/Assistant, in order to take that seat.
3. If a player who has won a seat into the tournament via another tournament conducted by the Casino (or that player's transferee), has not presented himself or herself to the Tournament Director/Assistant by the start time for the tournament, then:
  - a. the Tournament Director/Assistant may offer that seat to an alternate player on payment of the entry fee for the tournament; and
  - b. the value of the entry ticket (not including the tournament commission payable for the tournament) relating to the first-mentioned player (or transferee) will still be included in the prize pool for the tournament.
4. Late entries and/or alternate players (reserve players who are waiting on a seat to become available through the elimination of player/s or player/s not taking their seats) must be seated prior to the conclusion of the first four levels and are entitled to a full starting stack of tournament chips with a value of \$10,000.
5. All seating positions are at the direction of the Tournament Director/Assistant.

6. The re-buy period will be for the duration of the first four blind levels and is only available to a player who has exhausted his or her table stake. In this circumstance, the player must re-buy before the next round of play or the player will be eliminated from the tournament.
7. The tournament will conclude when only one player remains.
8. Any entry fees (less tournament commission) and re-buys for the tournament will go into the prize pool for the tournament and will be allocated according to the prize breakdown described above.
9. The tournament shall be conducted by the Tournament Director/Assistant in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in this document and the approved Rules of Poker Hold-em (Rules) and, in the event of any inconsistency, the Rules shall prevail.
