

Tournament Terms and Conditions

Tournament Name:	The New Sit 'n' Go Roulette Tournament

Tournament Details:

1. The following tournament conditions are to be read in conjunction with the Rules of Casino Canberra American Roulette. Each Tournament will be conducted by the Tournament Director/Assistant in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in this document and the approved Rules of American Roulette (Rules) and, in the event of any inconsistency, the Rules shall prevail.
2. Only persons eligible to enter the Casino and who are Infinity Rewards program members are eligible to enter a Tournament. Entries are non-transferable or non-refundable.
3. The **Entry Fee** for eligible participants to a Tournament is:
 - 3.1 \$25; or
 - 3.2 2,500 *Infinity Program* points.
4. An eligible participant, who meets the entry fee requirement (as above), may enter a Tournament by presenting a valid ID at the registration location between 17:30 and 20:30 (subject to the maximum number of participants in the Tournament not already having registered).

5. **Number of Players:** Minimum of 10 players / Maximum of 100 players for each Tournament. The places in a Tournament are strictly on a first-come-first-serve basis.
6. **Re-buys:** A player is allowed to have unlimited re-buys into a Tournament (subject to the re-buy occurring on or before 20:30). The fee for a re-buy is \$25. For the purposes of **clause 5**, a player who re-buys into a Tournament is not counted as a new entrant.
7. After an eligible participant has registered, or conducted a re-buy into a Tournament, the player's tournament session and seat allocation will be determined by the Tournament Director/Assistant (as per below).
8. A player must be present, in person, five (5) minutes prior to the notified start time of their allocated tournament session.
9. The top place-getters in a Tournament, will be the tournament players with the highest value of chips at the end of a tournament session conducted during the Tournament, and will be awarded prizes in accordance with **clause 19.1** below. Each player is only eligible for one (1) individual Tournament prize.
10. In addition, each player in a Tournament (**Tournament player**) is eligible for The New Sit n' Go Roulette Tournament Grand Prizes ('**Grand Prizes**').
11. At the conclusion of the Tournament to be held on 10 December 2018, the Grand Prizes are to be awarded (according to **clause 19.2** below), to the top five (5) Tournament players, as determined by the highest final chip balance obtained by a Tournament player in any of the tournament sessions conducted during the Tournaments.¹

Tournament session format for a Tournament:

12. Each tournament session will commence between 18:00 – 21:00.
13. A maximum of two (2) Roulette tables will be operated at any time during a Tournament.
14. Subject to there being a minimum of one (1) and a maximum of six (6) players allocated to a Roulette table for a tournament session, the Tournament Director/Assistant may determine:
 - 14.1 the allocation of players to each tournament session; and

¹ For the avoidance of doubt, each Tournament player is only eligible for one (1) Grand Prize (and only the Tournament player's highest final chip balance is relevant to the award of a Grand Prize).

- 14.2 the seat allocation of players at a particular Roulette table.
15. Every tournament session will consist of five (5) spins.
16. At the commencement of a tournament session, each player starts with \$500 worth of Tournament Chips.
17. After each tournament session, a player's final chip balance for the tournament session will be recorded by the Tournament Director/Assistant.²
18. All bets during a tournament session are to be according to the table limits for a \$5 minimum Roulette table.
19. **Tournament prize pool:**

19.1 Individual Sit n' Go Tournament prize pool

Each Tournament has a guaranteed prize pool of at least \$1,500³ and the prize pool for each Tournament shall be awarded to eligible place-getters according to the table below:

² For the avoidance of doubt, a player who has played in multiple tournament sessions does not get a cumulative score.

³ This means that if the aggregate of any entry fees and re-buys paid for a Tournament is:

- less than \$1,500, Casino Canberra will contribute the difference to the Tournament prize pool to make the prize pool up to \$1,500; or
- \$1,500 or greater, the entirety of that prize pool will be allocated in accordance with the table stated in **clause 19.1**.

19.2 Grand prize pool:

The top five (5) Tournament players across all Tournaments, as determined by the highest final chip balance obtained by a Tournament player in any of the tournament sessions conducted during the Tournaments, will be awarded prizes according to the table below:

20. Leader boards:

Tournament leader board

20.1 After each tournament session during a Tournament, the Infinity Rewards program membership number and final chip balance, with respect to those Tournament players who have achieved a final chip balance for the tournament session, which is in the top five (5) overall final chip balances for the Tournament (at that time), will be placed on the Tournament leader board.

20.2 The leader board will be displayed at the Tournament table(s) with updated scores at the end of each tournament session, and throughout the Tournament.

Grand Prize leader board:

20.3 A Grand Prize leader board for the Grand Prize pool shall be displayed on a screen on the main gaming floor, with updated scores throughout the period 6 August 2018 to 10 December 2018.

20.4 After each tournament session conducted during a Tournament, the Infinity Rewards program membership number and final chip balance, with respect to those Tournament players who have achieved a final chip balance with respect to all tournament sessions conducted during the Tournaments, which is (at that time) both:

- a. the Tournament player's highest final chip balance obtained in any tournament sessions conducted during the Tournaments; and

- b. in the top twenty (20) of all final chip balances obtained in any tournament sessions conducted during the Tournaments,

will be placed on the Grand Prize leader board.

Other Tournament terms and conditions:

- 21. In the event of a tie between two or more Tournament players, who are contesting the same distribution(s) of an individual Sit n' Go Tournament prize pool, or the Grand Prize pool, the relevant prize(s) shall be aggregated and divided equally between those Tournament players.
- 22. The aggregate of any entry fees and re-buys paid for a Tournament will go into the prize pool for that Tournament.
- 23. There shall be no Racetrack or Neighbour bets allowed during the Roulette Tournament.
- 24. A minimum of one chip on numbers or corners must be wagered per spin.
- 25. Failure to adhere to the Tournament terms and conditions will result in disqualification.
- 26. All prizes are strictly non-negotiable and non-transferable and are not redeemable for any other goods or services.
- 27. Affiliates, contractors, directors, and/or employees associated with Aquis Entertainment and/or the Host are not eligible to participate in the Tournaments.
- 28. The conduct of the Tournaments, including decisions with respect to the eligibility of persons to enter and the validity of entries and prizes, is the responsibility of Casino Canberra (via authorised members of the management team). Casino Canberra's decisions in relation to the Tournaments will be considered final and binding on every participant.
- 29. Guests must be aged eighteen (18) years or older in order to be eligible to access Casino Canberra (based at the Location) and/or participate in the Tournaments.
- 30. Persons who are 'excluded persons' are not eligible to access Casino Canberra (based at the Location) and/or participate in the Tournaments.
