\$5,000 Free Roll Poker Tournament 2018

The following conditions are to be read in conjunction with the Casino Canberra Ltd Rules of Poker (Hold-em).

- Game:** POKER – HOLD-EM
- Starting time:** 19.30hrs
- Dates:** Saturday, 13th October 2018
- Entry fee:** Nil.
Each player entering the tournament will receive \$2,500 in tournament chips.
- Re-buys:** A player is allowed multiple re-buys into the tournament according to clauses 8-9 of the general terms and conditions below.
A player who wishes to re-buy into the tournament will be required to pay a fee of \$25 for a re-buy.
A player who re-buys into the tournament will receive \$2,500 in tournament chips.
- Add-ons:** A player may complete an add-on at the end of the 6th blind level according to clause 10 of the general terms and conditions below.
A player who completes a \$25 add-on will receive \$2,500 in tournament chips.
- No of Players:** Minimum 10 - maximum of 60 plus Alternate players for the first 6 levels.
If the minimum number of players have not registered by 19:50 then the starting time for the tournament may be delayed by the Tournament Director/ Assistant up until 20:30.
The Tournament Director/ Assistant shall announce the revised starting time on or before 19:50.
If the minimum number of players has not been reached by the times notified as the revised starting time, the tournament shall not proceed.
Late entries, after the tournament has commenced, will be accepted subject to clause 7 of the general terms and conditions below.

Prize pool breakdown:

The aggregate of any re-buys and add-ons for the tournament will go into the prize pool for the tournament.

The tournament has a guaranteed prize pool of \$5,000.¹

¹ This means that if the aggregate of any re-buys and add-ons for the tournament is less than \$5,000, Casino Canberra will contribute the difference to the prize pool.

The prize pool for the tournament will be distributed as follows:

- the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place-getters in the tournament will be awarded an entry ticket (to the value of \$220) into the next scheduled monthly \$220 Poker Classic tournament (being on Saturday, 27 October 2018), and will be registered for that tournament; and
- the remaining money in the prize pool (after deducting the value of the three entry tickets i.e. \$660) will be awarded to eligible place-getters according to the table below:

Blinds: There shall be two blinds increasing as per schedule below.

0-15(mins)	\$25/\$50

Then doubling every 15 minutes thereafter with the big blind always double the small blind.

General terms and conditions

1. The tournament is open to Infinity members (**members**) only.
2. There shall be no limit to the number of times that players may raise their bets during a round of play.
3. The tournament will conclude when one player remains.

4. A player who has won an entry ticket (and registration) into the next scheduled monthly \$220 Poker Classic tournament may transfer that prize to another member.
5. A member claiming a seat in a monthly \$220 Poker Classic tournament, as a consequence of a transfer, must provide satisfactory evidence of the transfer to the Tournament Director/Assistant, in order to take that seat.
6. If a member (or eligible transferee) does not take their seat in a monthly \$220 Poker Classic tournament, the value of their entry ticket (not including the tournament commission payable for the monthly tournament) will still be included in the prize pool for that monthly \$220 Poker Classic tournament.
7. Late entries and/or alternate players (reserve players who are waiting on a seat to become available through the elimination of player/s or player/s not taking their seat) must be seated prior to the conclusion of the first six levels and are entitled to a full starting stack of tournament chips with a value of \$2,500.
8. The re-buy period will be for the duration of the first six blind levels and is available to a player who has exhausted his or her table stake. In this circumstance, the player must re-buy before the next round of play, or the player will be eliminated from the tournament.
9. There will be no minimum or maximum number of re-buys during the first six blind levels.
10. At the conclusion of the sixth blind level, all remaining players may take the option of an add-on for a fee of \$25. A player who completes an add-on will receive a further \$2,500 in tournament chips to be used in the tournament.
11. Any re-buys and add-ons paid by players in relation to the tournament will go into the prize pool for the tournament and will be allocated according to the prize breakdown described above.
12. All seating positions are at the direction of the Tournament Director/Assistant.
13. The tournament shall be conducted by the Tournament Director/Assistant in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in this document and the approved Rules of Poker Hold-em (Rules) and, in the event of any inconsistency, the Rules shall prevail.
