

Casino Canberra Roulette Tournament

10 September 2016

The following tournament conditions are to be read in conjunction with the Rules for Casino Canberra American Roulette. The tournament will be conducted by the Tournament Director/Assistant in accordance with these tournament conditions and the applicable rules of the game.

Entry Fee: \$100 or 10,000 Advantage points - open to Advantage members only.

Each player will receive \$2,000 in tournament chips at the commencement of the first round, \$4,000 in tournament chips for the semi-final round and \$10,000 in tournament chips for the final.

The first 30 players to pre-register will pay \$75.00 for their entry fee (up until the day before the tournament and only applicable to players paying cash for entry fees).

Date: Saturday, 10 September 2016

Starting Time: 19:00

No. of Players: Minimum of 10 / Maximum of 100 players

Prize Breakdown: The total prize pool will be \$5,000 that shall be distributed as follows:

1st – \$3,000
(plus entry into 'Casino Canberra Triathlon 3 Game Event' tournament)

2nd – \$1,500
(plus entry into 'Casino Canberra Triathlon 3 Game Event')

3rd – \$500

In addition to the prize pool:

- (a) the 1st and 2nd place-getters in this tournament are allocated an entry into the '*Casino Canberra Triathlon 3 Game Event*' tournament to be held on Saturday, 1 October 2016, subject to that placegetter notifying the Tournament Director/Assistant, at the conclusion of this tournament, that he/she intends to take up his/her entry into the '*Casino Canberra Triathlon 3 Game Event*' tournament; and/or
- (b) if, at the conclusion of this tournament, a 1st or 2nd place-getter does not notify the Tournament Director/Assistant that he/she intends to take up his/her entry in the '*Casino Canberra Triathlon 3 Game Event*' tournament to be held on Saturday, 1 October 2016, then the Tournament Director may determine that the next placegetter(s) in the final round is to be allocated an entry into the '*Casino Canberra Triathlon 3 Game Event*' tournament (subject to the next placegetter notifying the Tournament Director/Assistant that he/she intends to take up the entry into the '*Casino Canberra Triathlon 3 Game Event*' tournament)(**'roll-down entry'**).

If, between 12pm - 6pm on Saturday, 1 October 2016, a person allocated an entry into the '*Casino Canberra Triathlon 3 Game Event*' tournament under paragraph (a) or (b) above, has not registered for the '*Casino Canberra Triathlon 3 Game Event*' tournament, that person's place in the tournament will be filled by way of a lucky barrel draw to be conducted on Saturday, 1 October 2016 (please refer to tournament conditions for '*Casino Canberra Triathlon 3 Game Event*' tournament).

Format:

Round One:

The number of players per table, the number of elimination rounds, and the number of players to progress to the semi-final, will be in accordance with the attached Tournament Seating Schedule.

Semi-Final: The number of players per table, the number of semi-finals, and the number of players to progress to the final, will be in accordance with the attached Tournament Seating Schedule.

Final: The number of players on the final table will be in accordance with the attached Tournament Seating Schedule.

Spins: All Rounds including the semi-final and the final will consist of 10 Spins.

Table Limits: As per the limits of a \$5 roulette table.

Exceptions: Less than 19 players and there will be no semi-final.

In the case of a tie between two or more players for a seat in the next round, additional rounds of play will be completed as per rule 16.19 of the American Roulette rules until there is a result. Where there is such a tie in any round (other than the final), in circumstances where the tied players have no chips left, each player will be given the stipulated amount of tournament chips for that round; with the corresponding limits, and will play an additional 3 spins to determine which player(s) qualify for the next round.

Where there is a tie between two or more players in the final, rule 16.20 of the American Roulette rules shall apply.

Players will start each round with the stipulated amount of tournament chips for that round. Chips will not carry forward to subsequent rounds.

There shall be no Racetrack or Neighbour bets allowed during the Roulette Tournament.

A minimum of one chip must be wagered per spin.
