

Casino Canberra Blackjack Tournament

5th December 2016

The following tournament conditions are to be read in conjunction with section 20 Tournament Play, of the Casino Canberra Ltd Rules for Blackjack. The tournament will be conducted by the Tournament Director/Assistant in accordance with these tournament conditions and the applicable rules of the game.

Entry Fee: \$50 or 5,000 Advantage points - open to Advantage members only.

Each player will receive \$2,000 in tournament chips at the commencement of the first round, \$4,000 in tournament chips for the semi-final round and \$7,500 in tournament chips for the final.

The first 30 players to pre-register will pay \$30.00 (up until the day before tournament and only applicable to players paying cash for entry fees).

Date: Monday, 5th December 2016

Starting Time: 19:00

No. of Players: Minimum of 10 / Maximum of 100 players.

Prize Breakdown: The total prize pool will be \$5,000 that shall be distributed as follows:

Prize Breakdown

1st – \$3,000

2nd – \$1,500

3rd – \$500

Format:

Round One: The number of players per table, the number of elimination rounds, and the number of players to progress to the semi-final, will be in accordance with the attached Tournament Seating Schedule.

Semi-Final: The number of players per table, the number of semi-finals, and the number of players to progress to the final, will be in accordance with the attached Tournament Seating Schedule.

Final: The number of players on the final table will be in accordance with the attached Tournament Seating Schedule.

Hands: Round one will consist of 10 hands, the semi-final will consist of 15 hands. The final will consist of 20 hands.

Table Limits: For the first round, table limits will be \$10 Minimum/ \$500 maximum.

For the semi-final round, the table limits will be \$20 Minimum/ \$1,000 maximum.

For the final round, the limits will be \$100 minimum with a no-limit maximum bet

All bets are in units of \$10.

Exceptions: Perfect pairs betting will not be played.

The starting marker that is used to indicate the player who must make the first bet of that round will also indicate the player who has their cards dealt first in that round.

Less than 15 players and there will be no semi-final.

In the case of a tie between two or more players for a seat in the next round, additional rounds of play will be completed as per rule 20.21 of the Blackjack rules until there is a result. Where there is such a tie in any round (other than the final), in circumstances where the tied players have no chips left, each player will be given the stipulated amount of tournament chips for that round; with the corresponding limits, and will play an additional 3 hands to determine which player(s) qualify for the next round.

Where there is a tie between two or more players in the final, rule 20.22 of the Blackjack rules shall apply.

Players will start each round with the stipulated amount of tournament chips for that round. Chips will not carry forward to subsequent rounds.
